The following is a list of the 2013 state holidays and the dates on which they will be observed:

New Year's Day	Tuesday	January 1, 2013
Martin Luther King, Jr. Day	Monday	January 21, 2013
Good Friday	Friday	March 29, 2013
Memorial Day	Monday	May 27, 2013
Independence Day	Thursday	July 4, 2013
Labor Day	Monday	September 2, 2013
Columbus Day	Monday	October 14, 2013
Veterans Day	Monday	November 11, 2013
Thanksgiving Day	Thursday	November 28, 2013
Lincoln's Birthday	Friday	November 29, 2013
Washington's Birthday	Tuesday	December 24, 2013
Christmas Day	Wednesday	December 25, 2013

All full-time, part-time and hourly employees occupying permanent positions must be compensated for all holidays listed above. To be eligible for compensation, the employee must be in pay status during the week in which the holiday is observed. Employees are not compensated for holidays which are observed prior to the first workday of employment or for holidays which are observed after their last workday of employment. Full-time, part-time or hourly employees occupying permanent positions who are not scheduled to work on the dates listed above, and who do not work, shall receive holiday pay equal to one-tenth of their base bi-weekly salary. Employees occupying permanent full-time, part-time or hourly positions who do work on the holiday are entitled to payment for the hours worked and to the option of either payment equal to one-tenth of their base bi-weekly salary or compensatory time off for the holiday at the employee's discretion. Intermittent and temporary employees shall not receive holiday pay. Intermittent and temporary employees who work on a date indicated above will be paid for the hours worked.
